B. Roles and Responsibilities

1. Prevention and Awareness:

- Conduct awareness about the dangers and legal consequences of ragging for all incoming students and staff.

2. Monitoring and Surveillance:

- Regularly monitor common areas (hostels, canteens etc.) and be alert to any potential ragging incidents.
- Encourage the use of complaint boxes, help lines and digital platforms for students to report ragging incidents anonymously.

3. Investigation of Complaints:

- Receive and investigate complaints of ragging swiftly and confidentially.

- Ensure through investigation of all allegations, involving necessary authorities like the police or senior administrators if required.

4. Disciplinary Action:

- Ensure immediate disciplinary action against those found guilty of ragging, following the guidelines of the Anti-Ragging Act.
- Take appropriate legal and institutional action, including suspension or expulsion, if necessary.

5. Support to Victims:

- Provide counseling and psychological support to victims of ragging.
- Ensure that the victim's identity remains confidential during investigations.

6. Regular Reporting and Documentation:


- Maintain records of complaints, investigations, actions taken, and follow-up actions.
- Provide regular report to the college administration, including any actions taken or preventive steps implemented.

C. Monthly Meetings

The Anti-Ragging Committee will meet once a month on every last Friday too:

- Review the status of ongoing investigations.
- Discuss any new complaints or issues reported during the month.
- Plan preventive measures or awareness programs for the upcoming months.
- Ensure that all members are up-to-date with the actions and decisions taken.
